Why Legalism Fails

July 05, 2009

Phil 3:1-6

The word "legalism" describes any system of rules and regulations, demanding literal adherence, for achieving either salvation or spiritual growth, over-riding the doctrine of Grace. This passage demonstrates that faith based on the law can lead to the practice of circumcision, the smugness of racial superiority, the conceit of religious heritage and the pride of self-defined righteousness. The New Testament addresses this topic often - especially in Romans, Galatians, Colossians, Hebrews and John's epistles. Many pastors avoid these issues because of the challenge to customs, cultures and conscience. The Apostle says these principles are necessary for maturity of our faith in Christ (Phil 3:7-11).

Human principles look good but in restraining sensual indulgence (Col. 2:20-23)

Convictions vary about non-essential doctrines so we are instructed to:

- one another (Rom 14:1)

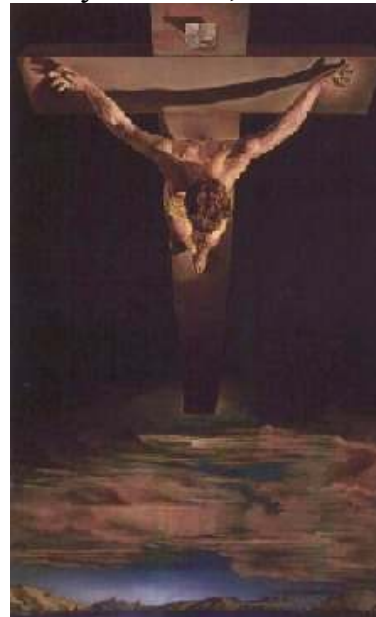
Wesley's Notes:
