“Heidi”. When her aunt tires of caring for her, 8-year-old orphan Heidi goes to live in the Alps with her gruff grandfather, who comes to adore her. Eventually kidnaped and placed with another family, Heidi fights to join her granddad again and he fights to find her. Unlike most modern films, this one features Church community and attendance, prayer and grace before meals, Bible reading (Prodigal Son), Christian message (The Lost Sheep - the 99 and 1), Christian hymns and Christmas carols (Silent Night), the good Christian pastor, Christian marriage, family love, friendship, good neighbour relationships, repentance and forgiveness. Some scenes may be too intense for very young children, namely, the kidnaping of Heidi by her evil aunt, the house arrest of Heidi by the other family’s evil housekeeper, and the imprisonment of Heidi’s grandfather.
